They are still doing assessments which means they are finding new needs every hour. As of this hour, what the United Methodist Disaster Warehouse needs are:
 Bow Rakes (Garden NOT leaf rakes)
 2 gallon garden sprayers
 Box fans
 25' three wire extension cords
 Large two wheeled wheel barrows Yellow or Red @ (Lowe's/Home Depot)
 UMCOR Cleaning buckets
 Tornado buckets
 Number 8 Common nails
 Clear Safety glasses
 Packing tape from Dollar Tree (about 1 1/2" wide)

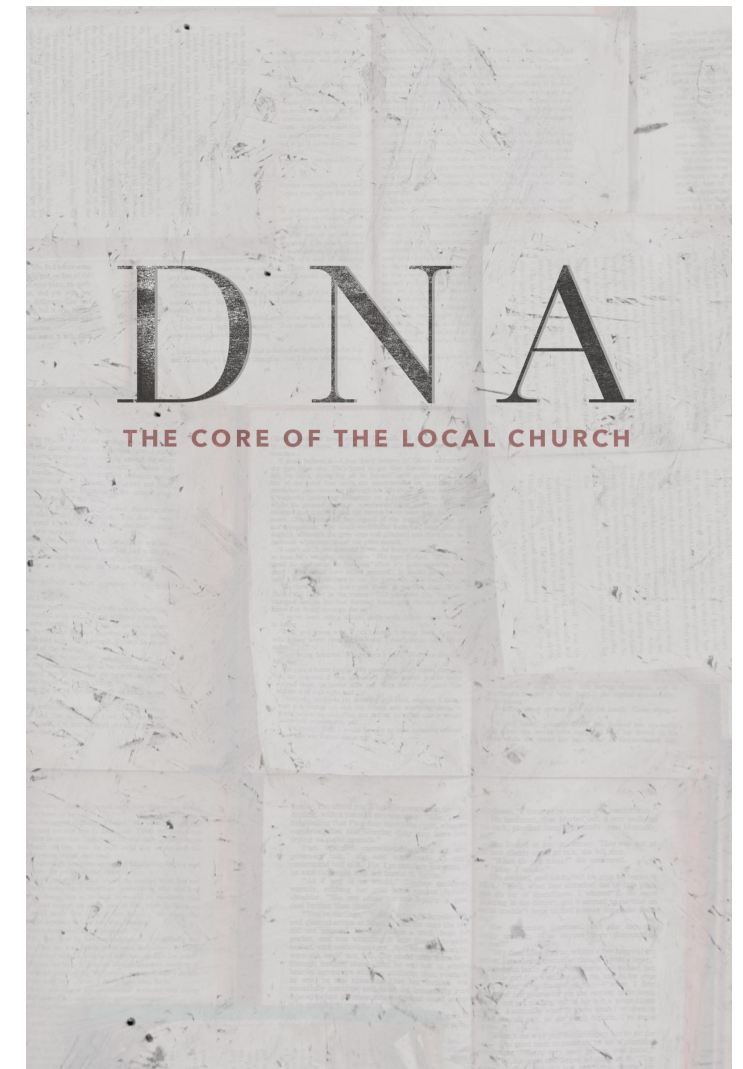
