## Christmas Shoeboxes

Kidz Central Christmas Shoebox Mission is underway. We will be doing things a little different this year. Instead of taking a box to fill, we ask that you take the list and buy the much needed items for the children. Please return the items by Sunday, August 26 to Laura or the Kidz Central room. This year we will be having a Christmas Shoebox Packing Party on Wednesday, August 29 at 6:00 pm. Christmas in August!!! **We will have a meal that night that will be \$6.00 a person, or if you bring all the items needed to fill 3 Shoeboxes, your meal is free!!!** We ask that everyone bring their favorite Christmas snack to share. There will be hot chocolate and lots of other goodies as we come together in fellowship and prepare to share the love of Christ for the children in Central America.

Last year the Mountain Lakes District donated 2,200 Christmas Shoeboxes. Christ Central packed 105 in 2017, 153 in 2016, 144 in 2015, and 102 in 2014. Jesus loved the children so much and the Christmas Shoebox Ministry reflects Christ's love to the children and their families. This year we hope to reach more children and families by doing as much as possible through this ministry. So please, prayerfully consider filling some shoeboxes this year.
